HOA President's

It is hurricane season, and I understand recently there was a post on social media claiming the board is not doing anything to prepare for flooding. That simply is not true, and if you attended the monthly meeting on June 3^{rd,} you would know it is not true. I will list again what we have been doing but realize GAV is in the flood zone and if flooding is a genuine issue with you, your best solution is to consider moving to a non-flood zone.

Here is what I said at the June 3rd meeting: A few months ago, I met with Vincent Cruz and showed him which storm ditches needed to be maintained and asked him to keep the vegetation trimmed on a regular basis.

A month ago, I set up a meeting with the gentleman from Suncoast Waterways who treats our retention ponds, and we walked each pond looking at the way they drain. I was told during that meeting that if the actual drains from the ponds are inspected and treated for weeds, they will remain in good working order. I did request an additional service at the time. I wanted the ditches leading to the canal sprayed to reduce weed growth on a regular basis. He gave me a quote of \$125.00 for each treatment and I told him to start next month. As luck would have it, I understand after his first treatment there was a heavy downpour washing away his work.

I also had numerous conversations and meetings with the city engineer over the past two years about our storm sewer drainage system and how well it worked. His response was it has worked as designed. We met several times about who had what areas of responsibility and are still discussing a few areas in question. We went back to the very beginning when GAV was first created and followed the trail of information we could locate to determine who had what responsibilities.

Two months ago, I attempted to have a few dredging companies come out and give us their assessment as to whether we need to dredge. Each one I contacted told me they do not dredge residential communities. I got the feeling it was for liability reasons. I still pursued it and found someone who would provide a quote. I met with them on May 2nd and we walked the ditches. Once we have the quote a special meeting will be scheduled for the board to discuss what we want to do or not do. The concern is that dredging can increase the amount of water that is stagnant in the ditches and could cause additional erosion without significantly improving water flow. Everyone I spoke with said the same thing...keep doing what you are doing and maintain the ditches. The city watched the water flow during Helene and said our system did an excellent job of managing the water. They added we did better than other communities in Oldsmar and reminded me that GAV is in **the flood zone** so to eliminate flooding is impossible unless you move to higher ground. Efforts will continue to minimize flooding in GAV.

The wall reconstruction project along Curlew is on hold until the work on Curlew is completed. The city of Oldsmar has asked us to "move slowly" to avoid adding more traffic congestion in that area with an additional construction crew. We will keep you updated.

One last thing, a big thank you goes out to Mike Breton for getting a new flag back up our flagpole right before the Memorial Day service. The rope used to hoist it broke and the flag fell to the ground. Thanks, Mike, we salute you for a job well done!



A HISTORY MINUTE

Shortly after Pinellas County came into being in 1912, Ransom Eli OLDS purchased 37,514 acres of land for a mere \$400,000 in 1916.

The area of that purchase that makes up Oldsmar was originally called "RE Olds-by-the Bay". A few years later it was renamed Oldsmar, "Olds" of course for our founder, and "mar", Spanish for the sea or any body of water. Hence "Olds at the top of Old Tampa Bay".

In 1927, to associate with the growing neighboring city, our name was changed to "Tampa Shores." In 1937 the name was reincorporated back to "Oldsmar".



Committee members are Peggy Allison, Carl Foley, Jill Kauss, Ralph Richardson and Randy Collinsworth.


