#### **HOA President's Letter**

I want to thank everyone for your patience while FDOT replaced the pipe at our main entrance. Using the Gull Road exit was a challenge at times, but it gave everyone an idea of how much traffic we have going in and out of our community. This is the reason it is so important that you drive slowly and carefully through the community.

As a reminder, the clubhouse will be closed this month, beginning on June 9<sup>th,</sup> to replace the floor. As it stands today, it is scheduled to be closed from June 9<sup>th</sup> until July 1<sup>st</sup>.

I met with two different companies to inspect our storm sewer ditches and obtain information about their proper operation. Both companies said that the way we are currently maintaining them is the right approach. Even though I was told we were maintaining the ditches properly, I will be meeting with a dredging company next week to see if they recommend dredging any of the ditches. I also contacted the City of Oldsmar about trimming the spillway ditches on the canal side of the fence, which they and SWFMD maintain.

Our retention ponds were treated by Sunwest Waterways during the first week of May, however, because the ponds were low due to the lack of rainfall, it was not possible to launch the boat usually used to spray the floating vegetation. They plan to bring a smaller boat this month and hopefully will be able to reach the vegetation.

On May 7<sup>th</sup>, I met with the survey company we hired to do the boundary survey at the fallen section of our wall. If you attended last month's meeting you might remember I told everyone we needed a boundary survey to obtain a building permit to repair the wall. This was unexpected, however, if all goes as planned, you should begin to see work done very soon. The only issue that might slow the process is the construction along Curlew Road.



#### **Architectural Committee**

Recently we have had a few requests for pavers in yards. The City of Oldsmar has really cracked down on where and how much you can actually do with pavers. When you are considering the use of pavers, you might want to go to the City Permit office and talk with them about what you want to do. I would suggest that you take your survey, draw your design and talk with them about what your desire would be. They will be able to tell you what you can get a permit to do.

Even though we might approve something, without a required permit you cannot move forward.

Do your homework. On our website there are several sections that talk about the heights of fences, the types and other useful information. There is also information about how many feet you have to have between your side property and back property lines. Not everything is just listed on the Architectural Guidelines.

Recently we have had to turn down patios because there just wasn't enough feet between property lines on the side or in the back. All this is on the website. We do not turn these down without a proper reason. Any of the committee members are willing to help answer questions or try to find out answers to the best of our ability. 
