President's Report - John Monser

• Treasurer Report -Tim Farmer

- This This report reflects the Association's financial status for the month of August and year-to-date.
- **Revenue**: For the month of August, our revenue is below budget by a total of \$330.46, with an actual amount of \$33,169 received and a budgeted amount of \$33,500. The year-to-date revenue, however, is above budget with an actual amount of \$242,042 received and a budgeted amount of \$234,500. Thus, the above budget revenue variance is \$7,542.73.
- Expenses: For the month of August, our monthly expenses are below budget by \$13,006 or actual of \$18,038 spent with a budgeted amount of \$31,045. Year-to-date expenses are \$13,070 below budget with an actual spent of \$204,244 and a budgeted amount of \$217,314.

• **Operating Capital**: The Association's operating capital is \$172,374, excluding reserve funds of \$266,368.

Ameritech Management Report - Dave Fedash

David reported we now have 5 accounts with the attorney:

1 lien filed, 2 lien notices, 2 bank foreclosures.

Total delinquent as of 8/31/24 is \$16, 009. \$12,317 are fines.

Violations – 30 new violations in September. No owners scheduled for CC meeting in October.

September CC meeting was held and 3 No-Shows. Fines approved \$25 per day to maximum of \$1,000.

Committee/Club Reports

<u>Architectural Committee</u> - Jill Kauss reports all good. If interested in opening please put name in BOD box in clubhouse for review.

<u>Social Club</u> – Dale advised we had a very busy summer. Pancake breakfast and Night at the Races coming up on September 28th. In October we have the Halloween Dance and Golf Cart parade. Decorate your golf carts and come for the parade. Chance to win prizes.

<u>Compliance Committee -</u> Dave Fedash reported no meeting was needed in September.

<u>Orientation Committee</u> Sue Van Vessem reported that she had 2 total scheduled. 1 fell thru and 1 is pending.

New Business:

• Motion made by Tim Farmer and seconded by Kathy Marro to discuss cost to repair hole and pipe behind 334 and 335 Canal Way. James Reinke spoke with 15 different companies to make this repair. GAV owns the drain system. It was owned by the city but at some point, years ago, it was signed over to GAV. The only company that is willing to take on the project is Globe Kings. Cost is \$1500 and thy can start on September 30th if approved. Motion by Sal Chieffo to approve and seconded by James Reinke. Approved by all on board.

Open to homeowners:

Paula Marrone – 509 Canal Way –Thanked the social club for all social events.
For the Bocce courts walkway in 2 courts need to be changed for safety. Tidal Wave Cement quoted \$4,000 to move stones and make a 4'7"x50 ft walkway.
