On Tuesday, May 1, 2018, Oldsmar City Council passed an ordinance to raise the Speed Limit in Gull Aire Village to 20 MPH. By Thursday, May 3rd they had already installed the new Speed Limit signs.

Pinellas County Sheriffs will now be ticketing speeders on our streets. Please observe the new speed limit, it is for the safety of all our residents and guests.

The smoking area of the Pool has signs designating the exact area where you are permitted to smoke. Please be courteous of all the non-smokers and only smoke where permitted. New ash trays will be coming in the near future.

The City of Oldsmar requires contractors or residents to obtain a permit for **all window and door replacements.** The reason for this is to verify the product approvals for the windows and/or doors, verify the contractor's license/insurance and reporting purposes to the Pinellas County Property Appraiser any improvements to the property.

Attention Gull Aire Residents

The City of Oldsmar requires a window/door compliance letter from your contractor upon completion of the job to close your permit. This compliance letter is a notarized document stating the contractor installed your windows and/or doors per the manufacturer's specifications. If the permit is being pulled as an "owner builder", the homeowner is responsible for providing the letter of compliance to the City.

If you feel your windows and/or doors have not been installed correctly please contact your contractor first.

Your residence may or may not require an inspection.

If an inspection is required your contractor will need to make arrangements with you the homeowner for the inspection as someone is required to be at the home. Inspections are performed Monday- Friday. You may call our office at 9:00am the day of your inspection to find out the timeframe for your inspection.

Please note that the Building Department is unable to schedule exact appointments for inspections, we can only give a general window timeframe for it to be completed.



ATTENTION

The City of Oldsmar Code Enforcement Officer will be doing golf cart inspections on Wednesday, June 13th at 10:00 AM at the Clubhouse. Please remember to bring your driver's license, proof of liability insurance and \$10.00 for your sticker. See Golf Cart Rules below:

The City designated Gull Aire Village a golf cart community <u>as a privilege – not a right</u>. We all need to use common sense and drive responsibly so that the City doesn't regret that decision and rescind that designation.

If you choose to drive a golf cart in Gull Aire, here are the requirements:

- ~ Valid Driver's License
- ~ Horn
- ~ Rear view mirror
- ~ Reflector (front & back)
- ~ Liability insurance on the golf cart (either as a rider to your homeowner policy or a separate policy)
- ~ All traffic laws must be observed

For those who intend to drive at night (dusk to dawn) in addition to the above requirements, your golf cart must also be equipped with:

- ~ Windshield
- ~ Headlights
- ~ Brake lights
- ~ Turn Signals

Also required is a City of Oldsmar issued golf cart sticker (cost of \$10 per year) displayed on the rear bumper (driver's side). In order to purchase the sticker, your cart will need to be inspected by Code Enforcement and you will be required to show your insurance policy covering the golf cart. In order to be inspected for the sticker, you will need to call Oldsmar's Code Enforcement, at City Hall (813-749-1129) to make a mutually agreeable appointment for him to meet you at the clubhouse to inspect your golf cart and issue a sticker. Be sure your golf cart meets the above requirements and that you have proof of insurance on the day of the inspection.

Additional requirements include:

- ~ Golf cart may not be occupied by more passengers than the number of seats and all passengers must be seated no standing in a moving golf cart.
- ~ Golf carts should not exceed 15 mph
- ~ Golf carts should not block traffic
- ~ Golf cars should be driven on the streets only no sidewalks, grass, etc.
- ~ Golf carts should be driven on the right side of the street only
- ~ Golf carts should be driven single file only driving abreast each other is prohibited
- ~ Golf carts are absolutely prohibited from being driven across Curlew that restriction applies to street legal golf carts as well.

And, once again – anyone driving a golf cart must have a valid driver's license – no exceptions!
