
SAFETY FIRST

Due to the increased traffic from the Woodland Center and on Curlew Road, we have seen several accidents at our intersection. Some have involved our neighbors.

Residents should be aware that when a driver is making a left turn onto a 3-lane highway, they are required to STAY IN THE EXTREME LEFT LANE when completing their turn. Then after checking the adjacent lanes to be sure there is clearance to change lanes, PUT ON YOUR TURN SIGNAL, and ease over to the middle or extreme right lane. It is important to mention this in relation to those residents exiting from Gull Aire Boulevard onto Curlew Road due to a lot of near miss accidents with cars exiting to the right from the Woodland shopping center. The distance from Gull Aire to McMullen Booth is ample enough distance to navigate all the way to the right lane. This also applies to any driver exiting from the shopping center and turning right to go toward Mc Mullen Booth Road - they are required to stay in the extreme right lane until they can signal and safely move to adjacent lanes.

Above all, be aware and be safe.


