

Labor Day is almost upon us and that means the Height of Hurricane Season. Please remember that we are in a Mandatory Evacuation Zone, should a Hurricane be predicted to head our way. Please have a plan in place and follow it.

It now empties within minutes. The wood above and below the outside kitchen window has been replaced and looks great. We have lost a few Residents this Summer and all of them will be greatly missed. Our deepest Sympathy to all of their families.






## SEPTEMBER 2018 MOVIE of THE MONTH CHAPPAQUIDDICK
