

PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE GULL AIRE VILLAGE SOCIAL CLUB BY- LAWS

Below are proposed changes to the Gull Aire Village Social Club By-Laws:

- 1) Additions are indicated in **BOLD**, **UNDERLINES AND CAPS**.
- 2) Deletions are indicated by strikethroughs.

Gull Aire Village residents can vote on these proposed changes at the Clubhouse at the Social Club meeting on Tuesday, February 12, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. Residents should review these proposed changes before voting.

PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE BY-LAWS

ARTICLE 4- TERMS of OFFICE

The term of office is one year. Each officer may serve no more than two-FOUR consecutive terms but may choose to serve again after an absence of at least one fiscal year. EACH OFFICER MAY CHOOSE TO SERVE IN A DIFFERENT POSITION FOR UP TO-2 4 CONSECUTIVE TERMS IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE HOLDING OF ANY OTHER OFFICE.

ARTICLE 10- MEETINGS

The Social Club meeting dates and times shall be determined by the newly-elected president and Social Club board. Social Club meetings will be suspended during the summer months of June, July and August. A quorum of 35 25 members must be present to conduct Social Club business. Special meetings may be called by the president providing notice is given to the general membership. Any special meeting shall be limited solely to the subject or subjects named in the call of the meeting. All meetings shall be conducted according to Roberts Rule of Order.

Our "Hosscollar" tournament was a huge success and everyone had a fun time. Our lunch was delicious and more than filling! Winners of the games were:


1st Place – Paul Allison 2nd Place – Debbie Campbell 3rd Place – Alice Szczur
