#### **Updated Architectural Guidelines**

The Architectural Committee and GAVA Board of Directors have approved the following changes to the Architectural Guidelines effective immediately. Please note that the City of Oldsmar requires <u>turf grass</u> to be installed on the front and side yard areas of the lot and shall be extended to the rear setback line. A complete copy of the Architectural Guidelines document is posted in the clubhouse and can be downloaded from the Gull Aire website www.gullairevillage.org .

Following is the list of **changes and additions** where the application and approval is not required.

- 1. <u>LANDSCAPING PURPOSES ONLY</u>: You can use mulch, gravel, stone and pavers on property for landscaping purposes [i.e. around plants, trees, patios, etc.] as long as it is **not** used for parking, to replace lawns, or over easements. A border is required to keep material in place. Per City of Oldsmar ordinance [Section 12.3.2.1]: Turf grass shall be installed on the front and side yard areas of the lot and shall be extended to the rear setback line.
- 2. Planting shrubs, trees (except citrus trees in front or street side yards) plants or flowers.
- 3. Decorative concrete borders are allowed except over easements.
- 4. If you are going to extend your pavers/project to your property line, then a <u>survey and A/C application</u> <u>MUST</u> be submitted to the Architectural Committee so easements can be checked for drainage purposes,
