UPDATE FROM THR PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS {BOD} GULL AIRE VILLAGE

TO ALL RESIDENTS:

As everyone is aware of the problems and concerns that we as a community are facing with the CORONAVIRUS I think it is only fair to keep everyone as up to date as possible during these very trying times, and I want to assure you that the GAVA BOD is very active in trying to take a proactive approach while trying to protect the health and welfare of our residents.

March 16, the BOD made the difficult decision to cancel all activities for a period of two weeks, with the exceptions being the clubhouse and pool remaining open pending further updates from the City, County or State officials. Stating that we would reassess the situation as best we could.

March 22, we found that due to a chemical imbalance with the PH levels being high we closed the pool and contacted the pool maintenance company to assist us. We feel that recent unprecedented events and our communities health concerns vastly outweigh keeping the pool open therefore the pool will be closed until further notice, and as in all matters that we are dealing with now this will be monitored on a daily basis.


