

#### **IMPORTANT - Rules & Regulation Changes:**

Signs: Flags, Signs, Banners, etc. of any political nature are not allowed to be displayed at any time.

No signs of any kind shall be displayed on any homeowner's property without permission except "for sale" or "for rent" signs of standard industry size. Those signs are limited to one per house and may only be displayed in a window – not on the lawn. General notices and articles for sale may be prepared for posting on the bulletin board in the clubhouse after approval of the Office Administrator

**Sheds/Storage Units: Only one shed/storage unit per residence.** Sheds will be installed in the back of house and within 1' (one foot) of the house. Sheds cannot extend past sides of house or installed on the sides or front of house. Cannot be more than 100 square feet in size or more than 10' (ten feet) in height. Must be anchored to the ground 18" to 24" (inches) deep with at least one anchor in each corner. All applications for sheds must have a diagram of size and location submitted with application. Exceptions will be considered.


## What are you waiting for??? It's not too late ......

#### "RULES OF THE ROAD"

**GOLF CART DRIVERS**- (according to City Ordinance F.S. 316.212(\*)).

According to the City of Oldsmar ordinances, pertaining to golf carts driven on city roads (which includes all Gull Aire Village roads):

it is unlawful for a person to drive a golf cart as to impede or block the normal and reasonable movement of traffic. It is the duty of the operator of a golf cart to **allow other motor vehicles to proceed** at the lawful speed on such streets".

Just to clarify - when you observe a motor vehicle behind you, golf carts should **move to the right of the road** to allow those vehicles to safely pass. The streets in our Village are narrow which makes it difficult for any vehicles to safely pass a golf cart, that sometimes is being driven down the CENTER of the road. It has been mentioned several times, that our golf cart status is a PRIVILEGE granted by the City and it may be **WITHDRAWN AT ANY TIME** should residents ignore or violate City rules.

#### **BICYCLE RIDERS** - (according to State Statue 318.18 and 316.2065(7))

According to the State of Florida Bicycle Laws -

Bicycles are considered vehicles under Florida Law which means while driving on the roads, you have a duty to obey all traffic rules and regulations too! These laws include **STOPPING AT STOP SIGNS**, using **LIGHTS AT NIGHT**, and **YIELDING** the right of way when entering any road, using hand signals before making a turn.

Bikers MUST ride as closely as practicable to the right-hand curb or edge of the roadway. If riding two abreast, riders must stay within a single lane. Riding more than two abreast is never allowed except on designated roadways for bike use only.

As a general rule, it is legal to ride a bike on a sidewalk, but riders have all the same responsibilities as pedestrians. They must yield the right-of-way to any pedestrian while on the sidewalk or crosswalk and must "audibly" signal before passing the pedestrian.

In our Village, it has been observed, that a FEW bike riders do not even slow down, or observe any oncoming traffic at the intersections. They just look straight ahead while maintaining their speed, as if in defiance of any oncoming traffic - some do not even have mirrors! The State LEGAL PENALTIES could include moving violations of \$60 and the rider may be deemed negligent and liable for civil damages.


