



Florida tells residents to humanely kill INVASIVE, TOXIC toads that are lethal to pets.

A species of warty, **TOXIC toads** is invading Florida yards as it multiplies across the state. They have also been spotted in the Dove Terrace area.

The CANE TOAD, also known as the Bufo Toad, is a POISONOUS amphibian that when provoked, can produce a milky white toxin on its back, a substance that is particularly dangerous to house pets. The toxin can leave a dog or cat in serious distress or dead in as little as **15 MINUTES**. Even Cane Toad tadpoles are toxic! It can cause burning eyes or skin irritation in humans who handle them. They look pretty gross – tan to reddish-brown, dark brown or gray, warty skin and their backs are marked with dark spots. They are typically very large – 4 to 6 inches long and sometimes can grow to over 9 inches.

The creatures breed after periods of rainy weather and the state's wildlife commission encourages homeowners to kill them whenever possible. According to the University of Florida, they will eat anything they can get into their mouths: bugs, crabs, roaches, spiders, other frogs, snakes, small reptiles, small birds and other small mammals. They will also eat pet food and human food scraps. The toads are also attracted to proteins in PET DROPPINGS – cat or dog – and these should always be picked up.

IMPORTANT – If your pet bites, licks or even sniffs this toad, **IMMEDIATELY** wipe the inside of the mouth and face with a damp cloth to make sure no toxins are swallowed or absorbed. DO NOT FLUSH OUT THE MOUTH WITH A HOSE as it can send the toxins down the animal's throat. Take your pet to a veterinarian immediately.

Should you capture one of these invasive animals, it is **against State Law** to just relocate it to somewhere other than your property. Florida's Wildlife commission recommends capturing it while wearing latex gloves and a plastic bag or use a deep bucket as it cannot climb out of the steep sides and then DISCARDING this **poisonous** amphibian.

You can also report sightings to EDDMapS.org or to our local animal control office.
