



During the October meeting the board was questioned if they are certified. The answer is most definitely YES, we all are and have been certified. I don't understand why we were asked but I want everyone to know that yes, the board is certified.

Another resident during the October meeting questioned why people were parking on the street and sometimes on the sidewalk. Our rules are rather simple and are as follows: "While parking on our city streets in Gull Aire is legal, please exercise common sense and consider the fact that the streets are narrow and sufficient space should be reserved for emergency vehicles to have access to all homes in Gull Aire Village. Lives can be saved and/or lost in a matter of seconds.

The board is looking into the cost to upgrade our security cameras in the clubhouse. The current system is outdated and has been going down without warning. We are currently soliciting for quotes and will let you know what we find. We are also looking at upgrading the lights around the pool with LED lighting. We have requested quotes on this project as well and again will let you know the outcome. These are just a few of the items we are looking at but ones that we have solicited bids on.

As many of you know who attended the October meeting, we will be getting a face lift of our pool coping. The coping is the top area of the pool where you might sit without getting in the pool itself. The current coping has cracked in several places and has soft spots. The Board voted and approved a bid we received from 5 Star Pools at the October meeting. The work will not begin before the first part of next year thus the pool will be available during the holidays.

On November 8, 2021, I attended the Oldsmar Leisure Committee meeting. I addressed the committee to request they investigate the possibility of getting a hard surface walkway from Canal Way to the canal. I hope by attending we can get some traction on this idea and maybe come up with a way to make it safer for our residents to get to the canal.

Architectural Committee

LATTICE: Lattices made from white vinyl or white PVC material may be used for the purpose of landscaping if they meet the following criteria:

- May not attach to the house or be used as an enclosure of any kind.
- Must be kept clean and free of mold.

Lattices made from white PVC material may be used for the purpose of carport décor or to shield garbage cans from view. Other possibilities will be considered by the Architectural Committee as well. Brown lattice of any kind is prohibited.

All Florida Building Code Permits for the City of Oldsmar will be issued by Pinellas County per a new Interlocal Agreement effective Wednesday, September 1, 2021. Under this, no permit is required for replacement of windows in any mobile homes or modular homes. Pinellascounty.org has a list of permits, codes, and fees for more information. This has to do with Florida Building codes concerning mobile homes.

ATTENTION GAV RESIDENTS living in "site built" homes

Recently when neighbors were putting on new roofs, getting new flood insurance or renewing their homeowner's insurance, they discovered their homes construction was incorrectly recorded in County records

Since these homes have vinyl siding similar to the manufactured homes, the inspectors ASSUMED the construction was a "frame built" and not a site built home with cinderblock exterior walls.

Owners of site built homes should review their policies to insure you are being charged for the correct type of construction on the flood insurance and home owners policies - this could save you some money!
