#### JULY/AUGUST 2021 PRESIDENT LETTER

We have been working to clean up areas around the community and do some beautification. The palm trees around the clubhouse have been trimmed. The entrance to the clubhouse should have new plants by the time this letter goes to print. The ditch by the corner of Lake Way and Tarpon has been trimmed back further in preparation for the rainy summer ahead. Some of the trimmings were intentionally left to form a barrier as vegetation grows over it. We are in the process of ratifying the new "Request for Documentation" form that will be utilized when a resident wants to receive a copy of any of our documents that are currently available. As a result, the board discussed it and have agreed to change it. The preferred method is to use Certified Mail as it provides tracking, however you can also utilize regular mail. Instructions on how to use the form will be attached to it once it becomes available.

Please make sure you are yielding the right of way to people on bikes and in golf carts. I personally witnessed some close encounters where the person driving a vehicle assumed the person in the golf cart was going to turn, when in fact they were not. It could have ended up with someone being seriously injured. So, let us all drive carefully and watch out for others.
