If you are wanting to make some upgrades you need to complete an Architectural request form which you can find in the clubhouse. The Architectural Committee will review your application to ensure you are within rules and regulations and that you are using approved materials. Bottom line is you need to get Architectural approval before beginning a project.

By now most if not all the snowbirds have left, and summer is here. I would remind you again that if you have not already you should prepare now for summer storms and the possibility of a hurricane. Look around the outside of your home and see what items need to be removed prior to a storm hitting our area and identify a location to safely store them. Keep a list of all important phone numbers and contacts where you have them readily available. And don't forget your pets! You should have their shot records handy should you need alternate housing. 




FREE JUNE 2021 GAV MOVIE "DISNEY'S MULAN"





Join us for coffee in the morning, lunch at noon, exciting hourly drawings and a share the wealth jackpot at the end of the show. Look for new vendors, as well as your returning favorites, as you join us for one of the best craft shows of the Season.

Please Read Carefully

Inside spaces are 8'W x 6.5'D and **tables and chairs are provided**. Outside vendors <u>must supply their own tent, table(s), and chairs</u>. All spaces are available for \$35 w/ \$5 extra for electricity (available indoors only). To allow us to keep the space fee at this low rate we are asking that each vendor donate one handmade craft item that will be placed in a guest incentive raffle. Each guest willing to pay \$1.00 upon admission will receive a ticket for a drawing that will be held each hour (10, 11, 12, 1, 2). All vendors will be supplied with raffle tickets that will allow them to give out (up to five per hour) to customers upon a purchase from their booth.

Tables or display items that extend beyond space allotted will not be allowed. All exhibits must be handmade arts and crafts. To maintain a diverse and exciting show for our customers, we reserve the right to limit the number of exhibitors selling similar types of wares. Early set up on the 26th will be available from 4:00 - 7:00 p.m. for indoor vendors only (we cannot provide overnight security for outdoor tents). After setting up on Saturday, all crafters must park behind the clubhouse providing more spaces in the front and side parking areas for guests.

We will be available to meet you at 7:00 a.m. for check in at the front of the clubhouse on Sat., Nov.27th. Once you have received your packet, you will be directed to the closest unload site. Volunteers will be available for assistance. Free morning coffee and donuts and lunch will be available on-site for purchase.

Important: Please keep in mind that we are a rain or shine event, permit only handmade arts and crafts exhibitors, reserve the right to deny vendors selling commercial merchandise and ask that each vendor accepts responsibility for their own space, merchandise, and sales tax. You must set up by 8:30 AM and remain for the entirety of the event. No refunds will be issued.


