This past year has been nothing close to normal. New residents were never afforded the opportunity to find out what it is genuinely like to reside in Gull Aire Village. All the activities were cancelled, and chances to meet people has been impossible. However, it is finally coming to an end. Activities are gradually reopening and people are enjoying being together.

April began with Koffee Klatch, Karaoke, and the Aloha party. All three activities were extremely well received and the residents who attended had a great time. I want to thank the people who donated their time to make these activities such a success. By the time you read this letter other activities should be on the schedule again. I have had numerous residents ask me about opening all the activities including having a monthly meeting in the clubhouse instead of on Zoom. This is the guidance and some answers we received this week.

As of April 5, 2021 people 16 and older can get the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine in Florida. People 18 and older can get the Pfizer, Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccine. This includes Florida residents and snowbirds. So, by the time this goes to print everyone in Gull Aire Village should have the opportunity to be vaccinated if they so choose. According to the CDC you can now gather indoors with fully vaccinated people without wearing a mask or staying 6 feet apart. You can also gather indoors with unvaccinated people of any age from one other household known to you (for example visiting with relatives who all live together as one household) without masks or staying 6 feet apart, unless any of these people have an increased risk for a severe illness. The wearing of masks will still be encouraged when meeting inside the clubhouse. This means life is beginning to return to normal. As we continue our plan to cautiously reopen, please continue to practice good hygiene so we do not reverse the progress we have made over the past few months but most of all start living life again!



HURRICANE EVACUATION ROUTE

Hurricane Season is June 1, 2021 thru November 30, 2021

Hurricane season starts next month and because of the increased activity, this date may even be moved ahead next year. I have been doing a little research.

Many Floridians do not recognize the danger residing in their own yards. Snowbirds and year- round Floridians that plan a short or long trip, or are preparing for evacuation from an impending storm, should be aware that large and small lose items can become dangerous projectiles during a hurricane or even if we get high winds from storms going up the east coast. These can be damaging to your property, the property of a neighbor or cause bodily injury. This includes lawn furniture, potted plants, lawn ornaments, garbage cans, recycle bins, bicycles, grills, and any other item that could become a flying object. All such items should be brought inside or otherwise secured to prevent this dangerous situation. Common courtesy and a little planning would be to think ahead and to be sure that there are no loose items outside our homes. It should be a routine just like turning off the water heaters, raising the a/c temp or holding the mail.

If a storm is approaching, we are given several days' notice. Don't wait until the last minute to bring in these objects. Get those out of the way, get your personal things and make sure you have an evacuation plan for you and your family. Also help your elderly neighbors if they might need help with their outside objects. Sometimes, people are too proud to ask for help and its better to be proactive than too late. Also, we might even check at the clubhouse to see about bringing in the chairs and loungers to protect our investments there. We are a village and must work together to be a better place. Stay safe during this hurricane season.
