President's letter:

I am pleased to introduce our new "pool Guy" Todd Hayward. If you were at the October meeting you no doubt heard, we have a pool expert looking out for us. Todd owned a pool business in Michigan for years and was the "go to guy" for the State of Michigan when it came to commercial pools. He has only been onboard for a couple of weeks and has already made positive changes that have improved the safety of our pool. Welcome Todd!

We also have a new board member, Gregory Stewart. You know him as "The Shed Guy" or "Stewart" as he likes to be called. Stewart is filling the vacant position left by Ralph Richardson. Welcome Stewart!

As you may know if you use the pool, the coping around the pool and spa has cracked in certain areas and needs to be replaced or repaired. The board has requested bids from 5 different companies to repair or replace both the pool and the spa coping. So far, we have 3 quotes and are waiting on 2 more. Hopefully, by the time you read this letter we will have selected one of the 5 to renovate the pool and spa.

In the October letter I told you I would keep you updated on the two spillway areas that lead to the canal. As of the writing of this letter, I do not have any added information or specifically what it will take to bring them into compliance. The engineering company that inspected both spillways is assisting us in identifying a company that specializes in repairing these types of spillways. Hopefully, I will have more to share on this project soon.

A note of caution for all residents. We have been informed that FEMA recently released updated, digital flood hazard maps that show the extent to which areas throughout the county are at risk for flooding. Some residents that were in an X zone may now be in an AE zone where flood insurance is mandatory. For further information please visit; myoldsmar.com/952/Know-Your-Flood-Risk

And finally, I just want to say Gull Aire Village is a special place to live. We have some of the greatest residents you can imagine. We sometimes take for granted just how lucky we are to live here. 




