



President's letter:

We were recently contacted by Ameri-Tech concerning the 2 spillways which lead to the canal. They are required to be certified every five years. This is on the canal side where the gates are leading to the canal. As I said, they are to be certified every 5 years and it has been 6 years since the last certification. We met with the engineer who is conducting the certification and discussed the broken/cracked concrete on the sides of both spillways. It appears over the years the hillside under the concrete has eroded causing the concrete to break and causing possible flow issues in the spillway. The engineer is conducting a research of the history of both spillways to determine who is actually responsible for that portion ditch along with mapping of how it was constructed. We are currently waiting on his report.

I have been notified AGAIN about residents not picking up after their dogs. It is a rule that you use a leash when your dog is outside AND you pick up after them. I suggest, if possible, you have your dog use your yard prior to walking him or her, otherwise let's be respectful of our neighbors and pick up after your dog.

We are in the process of obtaining additional quotes on the pool and spa decking to repair the cracked coping and loose pavers. We had difficulty getting anyone to give us a quote a few months ago as a result of contractors being short staffed. Hopefully we can now obtain 2-3 quotes and move forward with getting the much-needed repairs completed.

I want to mention for those of you who are not aware the City of Oldsmar mailed out letters in July to residents that had a paver driveway, and the pavers were installed across the city sidewalk concerning a code violation. First, you are required to contact the city to see if a permit is required before making changes to your driveway. In this case some had permits some didn't. However, after discussion, the city decided to "grandfather" residents in so they would not have to have the pavers removed. Thank you to Mayor Seidel, the City Permit Employees and Engineers and also to the residents of GAV!

We had a few residents raise concerns about chain fences both at the corner of some lots as well as ones used to go across driveways when residents are gone. The board will be looking into if our rules need updating on "fencing". I know from personal experience I had a small chain fence on the corner of my lot. It had been there for many years before I purchased the property and I assume it was installed to protect the lawn. I removed mine, but are we going to make others remove theirs? Is this like the paver issue something where we "grandfather" in the ones who currently have them or requested them? Many of them have been there for years as was mine. Do we add language to our rules about future chain fencing or do accept what we have in the rules currently and move on? These are questions the board will be discussing and will address soon.

We recently had the ditch near Trout and Sailfish cut back and cleaned. Previously we had the ditch near Lake Way and Salmon cut and cleaned out. It has been difficult lately to have contractors take on additional work as they are still recouping from the impact of Covid-19 or they are behind because of all the rain. They now seem to be in much better shape and have hired workers back. In order to save money and not worry about both areas in the future we will be soliciting bids for a contract to maintain both areas.

Architectural Guidelines

ADDITIONAL PARKING PADS/ DRIVEWAYS/ WALKWAYS/ PATIOS

You must use pavers, concrete or asphalt, pending city permit. No gravel, shells, or mulch is permitted. All applications must have a diagram of size, location, and type of material to be used. If you are using pavers, please indicate the color of pavers and provide a sample picture. A survey of property must be submitted with the application.

Also remember that the City owns the sidewalks and there can be nothing on their property. If you have any plants on the sidewalk, those should be removed. Also, sidewalks cannot be painted or covered with pavers.




