



Architectural Guidelines

Now that Spring is almost here, I wanted to remind you of a few things when sprucing up your homes:

APPLICATION REQUEST AND APPROVAL ARE **NOT** REQUIRED FOR THE FOLLOWING: LANDSCAPING PURPOSES ONLY: You can use gravel, mulch, shells, stone and landscaping stones on property for landscaping purposes only (i.e. around plants, trees, etc.) as long as it is not used for parking or to replace lawns. Any expanded use requires approval. A border is required to keep material in place. Turf grass shall be installed on the front and side yard areas of the lot and shall be extended to the rear setback line. Landscaping blocks can be used around manufactured home skirting to protect skirting from weed eaters.

Planting shrubs, trees (except citrus – no citrus trees in front and street side yards), plants or flowers.

Decorative concrete borders are allowed.

Tree Removal: Residents should contact the City of Oldsmar for information, phone 813-749-1100.

ATTENTION SEASONAL RESIDENTS: As you are preparing to leave for the summer, remember it is imperative that any outdoor decor, flags, chimes, flowerpots, etc. that are not securely weighted or anchored to your property, should be removed before you depart for the summer.
