

GOLF CART OWNERS

For those residents who have golf carts or are new owners of a golf cart, this <u>City of Oldsmar Ordinance</u> needs repeating:

SEC 66-108. City of Oldsmar ordinance

- Golf carts CANNOT be operated by UNLICENSED operator (That includes visiting grandchildren)
- the **number of occupants** in any cart being operated on the City streets, shall be **restricted to the number of seats** on the cart. (Important to know when the grandchildren are visiting. Infants are not allowed to be on the driver's lap)
 - it is unlawful for any occupant to stand at any time while the cart is in motion.
 - maximum attainable speed 20 miles per hour.
- it is unlawful to drive at such a slow speed as to impede or block the normal and reasonable movement of traffic. IT IS THE DUTY OF THE OPERATOR TO LEAVE THE PAVED SURFACE OF THE STREET TO ALLOW OTHER MOTOR VEHICLES TO PROCEED.
- it is unlawful to operate on City sidewalks (such as in the Village), right-of-way and other locations on which a motor vehicle cannot be operated.
- it is unlawful for any cart to be operated on City streets UNLESS AND UNTIL THE OWNER HAS PURCHASED LIABILITY INSURANCE against personal injury and damage to property relative to the operation of the golf cart on City streets. Proof of insurance MUST be presented to the City upon registration and licensing and to a law enforcement officer or code enforcement officer upon request.



All Florida Building Code Permits for the City of Oldsmar are now being issued by Pinellas County per a new Interlocal Agreement effective Wednesday, September 1, 2021. The best way to understand what you need to do is access The City of Oldsmar web page to determine what is needed, then go to the Pinellas County web page for additional information.

Thank you to all who have been completing applications whether they have been needed or not. A copy of all permits must be submitted to the A/C committee inbox in the clubhouse prior to the commencement of the project. The original permit must be posted at the job site. Hopefully by the next issue we can relay to you more information from the city.
