President's Letter

This month we have a local election in Oldsmar for city council seat 2, the city mayor and 11 different Charter Amendments (they are minor changes in the wording of already approved amendments). Voting in person takes place on March 15, 2022, and early mail in voting started on February 8, 2022. No matter who you support take the time to vote. When politicians see most of their constituents vote it tends to make them keep their promises and to respond to the issues in the community once elected.

I received a letter from the Florida Department of Business & Professional Regulation (DBPR) concerning liens on homes. You may have received one too, but I thought for those who did not I would share the information in the letter. The letter warns citizens that when they have work done by a contractor to make sure they receive a "Release of Lien" prior to making the final payment for the work. In addition, find out if the contractor has any sub-contractors that they used and have them also provide a release of lien. The reason according to the DBPR is a lien could be placed on your home and the property could be sold against your will to pay for labor, materials, or other services which your contractor may have failed to pay. With spring coming and residents taking on special projects I thought this information might be useful. If you want additional information, contact DBPR directly.

And remember if you do decide to tackle a project do not forget to fill out an application and submit it to the Architectural Committee for approval before beginning.

As for project updates, we should have at least two final bids on the spillway within the next couple of weeks. As of this letter, the pool coping work has not been scheduled and once we have a date it will be shared. The board is considering additional upgrades in the community but until we receive the quotes on the spillway and know exactly what it will cost, we will not be moving forward with approving other projects.

And finally, I would like to thank the board and all the committee members for their hard work over the past year. We would not be the great community we are without their support!

Architectural Guidelines

The City of Oldsmar and Pinellas County now have an interlocking agreement with each other in regard to permits. The following need to obtain permits directly from Pinellas County, Pinellas County Building Department:

- Electric (on private property only)
- Plumbing (on private property only)
- Window/doors/garage doors (Not for original windows of modular homes)
- Roofs
- Soffits, Fascia and Siding *
- Mechanical and A/C changeouts
- · Gas permits for natural gas without new service
- Sheds >100sf (sheds <100sf are City only)

*If property is located within the Community Redevelopment Area or along the Tampa Road Corridor you must receive architectural approval from the City of Oldsmar.

You can also go to <u>Building Division | Oldsmar, FL - Official Website (myoldsmar.com)</u> for further information. Any one of our AC committee members will help you as much as we can to get the information that you need.



If any of our veteran families are in need of help with claims or other issues, please let us know and we will explore assistance.











- Oldsmar Public Library, 400 St. Petersburg Dr. W.
- Cypress Forest Recreation Center, 650 Pine Avenue N.
- Gull Aire Clubhouse. Please limit the pieces to just those that you will complete.
- The puzzle pieces will be available from Monday, February 14 and must be returned to one of the above locations by Friday, March 18. A box will be available in the Gull Aire Clubhouse where you can deposit completed pieces.
- You can use any medium of your choice to decorate **ONE SIDE** of the piece crayons, paint, colored pencils, charcoal, watercolors, collage, or photography, etc.
- You can create a self-portrait or full-body portraits of yourself or even your family, and don't forget your pets! Why not have the whole family create one together?
- Please write your name on the back of each jigsaw piece.

Once we have collected all the finished pieces, we will assemble them into a giant mural on the walls of City Hall and hold an exhibition of portraits that represent our community. All the puzzle pieces will fit together demonstrating how important it is that we, as individuals, are all part of a larger picture. We are connected to



Oldsmar in Orbit Planet Walk

Have you ever tried to imagine how large our solar system is?

The distance between the planets and our Sun is almost too great to calculate. You can experience a hike of a mile or two or even a hundred-mile car drive, but when it comes to the vastness in space, it's almost incomprehensible. That all changes with a unique planet walk called Oldsmar in Orbit, coming this Spring to Oldsmar. Explore the wonders of the solar system and be in awe of how much space there is in space!

Spanning nearly a mile, this scale model of 4 billion miles-to-one showcases each planet with an informational sign featuring planetary facts, astrological symbols, and the planets in relationship to each other.

The Oldsmar in Orbit Planet Walk begins at the Sun sign inside R.E Olds Park. Each planetary sign is placed proportionally to its actual distance from the Sun. Since the planets never actually coincide in a linear order, by walking directly from the Sun sign, you can visit each planet in any order and experience their enormous spatial relationships.


You can stroll to the nearest inner planets, Mercury, Venus, Earth, and Mars, from the Sun. A little further will be the outer planets - Jupiter and Saturn. Almost half a mile away at Veterans Memorial Park, you can visit the planet Uranus. And at the Public Library, you will find Neptune. Finally, nearly a mile away at Bicentennial Park, you'll discover Pluto.

What makes Oldsmar's Planet Walk unique is a feature called augmented reality. Watch each planet come to life in a 3-D format by downloading the FREE 'Oldsmar In Orbit' mobile app from the Apple Store or Google Play.

Former astronaut Nicole Stott narrates this stellar app. The Pinellas County native spent 104 days in outer space as a crew member on the Space Shuttle and International Space Station. You can hear Ms. Stott explain fascinating facts by clicking on the planet icon featured on each Planet Walk sign with your mobile phone.

The official 'launch' of Oldsmar in Orbit will be Saturday, March 5 at 10 am in R.E Olds Park. Members of the St. Petersburg Astronomy Club will arrive at 9:30 am with telescopes and stay throughout the day and evening for continued galactic explorations for everyone to enjoy.
