#### President's Letter

I would like to begin this month's letter reminding everyone how fortunate we were to have hurricane IAN go south of us at the last hour. It could have destroyed Gull Aire Village had it stayed on the original forecasted path. Let this be a reminder to take all hurricanes seriously. So please always be prepared and have an evacuation plan. You might also take this time to review your insurance policies and make sure you have satisfactory coverage. For those in our state that were seriously impacted by IAN you can help them by making donations to local and state emergency relief funds.

The board recently requested a quote on adding a card access security system to the clubhouse and pool area. We have had people who are not residents enter the pool area and we decided to look at a way to limit access. There are many things to consider if we were to implement a card system so this is not something that will be done overnight but at a minimum, we will have an idea of the estimated cost.

The microphone/intercom system in the clubhouse failed during Bingo. Perry Burright took the receiver and microphones to the retailer where they were purchased and was told they could not be repaired. While at the retailers Perry was able to find a new system for less than it might have cost to repair the old one, so we are back up and running! Thank you, Perry.

As many of you know, we were forced to cancel the September monthly meeting because of hurricane IAN. I had planned to bring up some issues concerning violations of our rules at the meeting but with the cancelling was not able to. I will touch on three of them now in this letter. The rest will be addressed at the October meeting. I would like to start out by saying the ones violating the rules seem to be the same ones pointing out violations in others. There is a saying that goes like this: "Judging others is easy because it distracts us from the responsibility of judging ourselves." Let us focus on making sure we follow the rules so that they do not have to be changed. Here are the three violations: 1. Feeding of wildlife. It is not permitted in GAV so do not do it. 2. Smoking. You are to smoke in the designated smoking areas not in or at the side of the pool and cigarette butts are to be disposed of properly not left on the decking. 3. Pool Showers. The showers in the pool are for rinsing only not bathing. You are not to use soap in the pool showers. Thank you for your cooperation.

The spa as you may have heard has a leak and we think it is in the suction piping. Todd has been trying to isolate it and once he is sure where it is located, we will let you know. Hopefully, it is in a location that has easy access and can be repaired for a reasonable amount.

And finally, I would like to welcome back the snowbirds. You missed a long sweltering summer let alone hurricane IAN but you returned in time to enjoy great Florida weather! Welcome back!
