

President's Letter

It is March and in Florida it is the time of year when the flowers begin to bloom, and the plants and trees come alive. It is one of my favorite months of the year as the temperatures are in the 70s and 80s and normally, we have plenty of sunshine. It is also the time of year when many of you will start outdoor projects. If you are planning to make changes to your property, remember to check our regulations and the Architectural Committee guidelines to ensure you are staying within the GAV rules.

The men's and women's saunas have a fresh look. We purchased and installed new sauna mats. Todd is working on repairing the men's sauna. It has been taking twice as long to heat up and while investigating the problem he found the incoming power line had overheated to the point it had burned the insulation and was a fire hazard. Hopefully by the time you read this article, if parts are readily available and we can get an electrician to come out and replace the wiring, it will be back to being fully operational.

We evicted a couple of people recently for not being over 55 years of age. I want to thank the residents who reported them. If a resident notifies a board member of a possible violation within the community the board will investigate it. Many times, though it appears to be a violation it has either been corrected on its own or it is simply not one. One example is we received a complaint that people under 18 years of age were living in a home on Pelican. When we went to investigate, we found they had been visiting but had moved out. On the other hand, we received complaints about people under 55 living in two other homes. We investigated and though we were met with resistance, we went through the eviction process and removed them. If you observe something report it and a board member will investigate it.

And finally, I want to thank everyone who has come to me lately with positive comments about the board. It is nice to hear good things! As you know board members dedicate their time to help keep GAV a beautiful place to live. We are not perfect by any means, but we do work hard and to receive positive feedback makes it all worth it.
