

PRESIDENT'S LETTER

There were two items brought up at our last monthly meeting that I would like to address those of you that were not in attendance. First, parking around the clubhouse. A resident complained that cars were being parked overnight around the clubhouse without authorization. Our rules are clear, overnight parking at the clubhouse is prohibited. The board will check the cars/trucks at the clubhouse and make sure the owners understand our rules.

Second, speeding in the community. Another resident complained that people are not being careful when driving through our neighborhood. I would remind residents not everyone can hear or see you coming so let us be careful and drive accordingly. Just because the posted speed limit is 20 mph doesn't mean driving at that speed is always safe.

At the March meeting the board approved numerous items on the agenda. The pavers for the smoking area, to have the clubhouse floors stripped and waxed, to upgrade the pool lights to LED lights, and to resurface the spa filter tank. In addition, we recently requested a roof inspection where some problem areas were identified, and we are waiting for the final report. We also decided to investigate having the chairs in the clubhouse cleaned and are currently requesting quotes. As of this writing, the pavers for the smoking area have been installed, the clubhouse floor waxing is being scheduled, the spa tank resurfacing is expected to be done by April 11th, we have obtained two quotes on cleaning the clubhouse chairs and the lighting contractor has ordered the LED lights for the pool area!

Summer is fast approaching so I want to remind everyone we will not have monthly meetings in June, July, and August. Stay cool and enjoy the summer!
