St. Pete Tarpon Canal Crossing Update

During the first couple of weeks of December, Mears, the Archer Western's horizontal directional drilling subcontractor, will begin mobilizing on both sides of the Tarpon Outfall Canal. Equipment will be brought into the Gull Aire Village RV lot through Montego Court, and pipe will be delivered on the Safety Harbor side.

Meanwhile, Archer Western is working to obtain proper permission from the Southwest Florida Water Management District to install the second sidewalk connecting the canal path to the sidewalk along Canal Way. Sidewalk installation for the first is scheduled for the first week of December.

No work will occur Monday, Dec. 23, through Saturday, Jan. 4.

In January, Mears will install vibration and acoustic monitors around the work zone and begin installing the casing for the drill. This is the noisiest part of the operation and will last for approximately two weeks. Horizontal directional drilling will begin immediately afterward.


Golf Cart Owners -

As we approach the upcoming holidays and visitors will be arriving, this is a reminder to new or existing golf cart owners, according to the 2024 Florida Statute (316.212) "a golf cart **MAY NOT be operated by anyone UNDER 18 years** of age unless they possess a <u>valid LEARNERS PERMIT or valid DRIVER LICENSE</u>". This also bears repeating – it is **illegal to have a young child or infant sitting on the driver's lap** while in operation.

Golf cart drivers should also <u>YIELD RIGHT OF WAY</u> to other motorized vehicles by pulling over to the side of the road to allow vehicles to safely pass.

Our Golf Cart Community is a privilege allowed by the City of Oldsmar. This privilege can be rescinded at any time, if the City feels the residents are not abiding by the Florida Statutes laws.


