

PRESIDENT'S LETTER

It is the beginning of a new fiscal year. We have a new board and plenty of work ahead. However, before we start with the new, I would like to give thanks to Stewart and Randy for stepping up and doing an outstanding job over the past two years. The old board would not have been as successful as it was without them! Thanks guys! Now you can just enjoy life and not answer all the questions and listen to all the village concerns!

In case you have not heard, the pool hours have been changed. The pool will now close at 10:00 pm instead of 11:00 pm. This was done to save on electricity and allow Todd an extra hour to prepare the pool for the following day. The old board decided to try these new hours on a temporary basis and later assess if it is to become permanent...stay tuned.

If you attended the special meeting on January 30, 2024, you heard the presentation given by the Archer Western Construction Company who will be replacing the water pipe that spans through our community and crosses the canal. Residents that did attend learned how they plan to install the pipe underground and the impact it will have on GAV. To minimize the impact the old board agreed to allow the use of the RV lot at the end of Salmon Court to stage equipment and set up the drilling machine. Otherwise, they would be driving their trucks in and out through our streets disrupting the whole community and possibly causing damage to our roads. This way they will be able to enter and exit via a gate from the subdivision behind the RV lot directly to the lot. By allowing the use of our lot the board agreed to enter into a Right of Entry Agreement. In this agreement, the community will be assured that when the construction is finished the contractor will restore the lot back in the same or better condition than when they started, they will provide alternative storage of the RVs that use the Salmon Court lot at the contractor's expense, they will remove the invasive Brazilian Pepper trees along the ditch behind the homes on Salmon and Trout but leave the good vegetation, provide optional temporary living arrangements for residents adjacent to the drilling machine, and construct sidewalks for pedestrian traffic only at two locations from Canal Way to the Outfall Canal for residents to use to access the canal walkway.

FYI - SETBACK or EASEMENT?

Residents who are starting new outside projects need to be reminded that, as a "deed restricted" community, there are certain requirements for outside improvements.

In accordance with our covenants, residents are required to submit an Architectural Change Request PRIOR to commencement of the work. (Applications are online and available in the clubhouse).

There has been confusion between a setback or easement, especially if you are installing a PERMANENT improvement, such as a shed.

An **EASEMENT** is the area which gives the right to access your property for a specific purpose – should any utilities company need to dig up your lawn to repair the underground connections that may run between or in back of you and your neighbor's property. Therefore, according to our covenant it is not allowed to put anything "permanent" in that area. Should there be anything hindering the companies from accessing these areas, they have the right to remove it and not replace what was added.

A **SETBACK** is the minimum distance a building or structure must be "setback" from the surrounding property lines. This would apply to again adding a "permanent" structure such as a room expansion or shed. An Architectural Change Request should be submitted prior to commencement of work PLUS it is highly recommended that you or your contractor contact the City to inquire if a City Permit is required for your project.






