ARCHITECTURAL GUIDELINES

These guidelines are not to be considered exclusive nor override any existing deed restrictions or covenants of Gull Aire Village. Nor do these guidelines superimpose any existing requirements for the City of Oldsmar. Owners who propose to change the exterior of their home or property must submit an application for the proposed change to the A/C. Application forms are available in the clubhouse by the bulletin boards. Homeowners whose applications have been denied by the A/C have the right to appeal to the BOD.

- AC complaints. Outside painting has been occurring without turning in applications. Please fill out an application and turn it into the AC box in the clubhouse.
- Also with spring hopefully around the corner remember all applications need approval before any project can be started. Even though the AC committee approves your project the city also has to approve certain ones.
- Your committee is here to help and guide you any way we can. We can come to your residence to give advice to make your project work if able. Most guidelines are online in GAV.org.

Your AC Committee is here to help you with questions should you have any in regard to changes to the exterior of your home.


