HOA President's Letter

In December, the board began the challenge of creating the 2025 budget. Every year we face changes that impact our expenses and revenues and being able to predict those changes is often difficult. We utilize history along with estimates for future cost changes to produce a monthly HOA fee. During the January monthly meeting, the board will present the new budget to our residents and vote on whether to ratify it.

The Tarpon Crossing Project is underway. The project team has asked that I relay a message to you. If you have questions or concerns about the project, please contact the project team directly at:

Do not call the City of Oldsmar as they do not have any information about the project.

This year the board will tackle many projects. The first two will be replacing the clubhouse floor and updating the Bocci courts. We did receive an estimate of the cost for the bocci courts, but we need to decide on what type of clubhouse floor we want as a replacement and then solicit bids. As we select the type of floor we will present residents with a few choices and ask for your input on which one to choose. We may also look at constructing a vinyl privacy fence around the Salmon RV lot. Once the Tarpon Project is complete the residents near the lot might want better privacy than just vegetation plus it will add a cleaner look for everyone.

We have a great support team with Todd, Anastasia, and Alice. I ask if you have any concerns about what they are doing, that you refer them to the board and not to them. They all work extremely hard to keep GAV a wonderful place to live and do not deserve to be criticized by individual residents. They report to the board and that is where any complaints should be directed. I would add this would also apply to the contractors we employ. If you have a concern with them report it to the board and we will manage it, not to the contractor.

It is a new year, and I am optimistic about the future of GAV and its residents. We will have our challenges as we do every year and will face them accordingly. I hope you enjoy GAV and have a wonderful year!

St. Pete Tarpon Canal Crossing Update

Happy New Year!

In December, Properly Inspected completed the home inspections and sent reports to homeowners. Archer Wester originally planned to mobilize the tunneling equipment in early December, but delays in permitting have delayed this activity. Mears, the tunneling subcontractor, is now planning to mobilize equipment in January, install vibration and acoustic monitors around the work zone and begin installing the casing for the drill. This is the noisiest part of the operation and will last for approximately two weeks. Horizontal directional drilling will begin immediately afterward.

The City of Oldsmar continues to get calls from residents about the project – complaints, questions, concerns, etc. The City has asked that we remind residents to direct questions or concerns to the project team at StPeteTarponCrossing@gmail.com or (813) 486-0361 to ensure a timely response.



A: Hey! 'Round' is also a shape!




