PRESIDENT'S LETTER

The City of Oldsmar is looking to make a change that will impact our RV lot. On November 3, 2025, at his request, I met with the Oldsmar City Inspector about our RV lot on Salmon Court. He wanted to discuss tentative plans for an emergency entrance at the RV lot for first responders. The city plans to extend Salmon Court and connect it with Montego Court. There will be a gate that will stop access to both Salmon Court and Montego Ct, and no one will have access to it, except first responders. The idea is to decrease the response time to our community in the event of a fire, medical emergency, or other tragedy. It also ensures that if any of our other entrances are blocked for any reason, first responders will be able to enter our community. Along with the gate for response vehicles, there will be a walk-through main gate also, which will be kept locked. Both the city and GAV will have a key to this gate. Our lot will be graded so that water drains to Montego Court not Salmon Court, and so firetrucks can enter safely. The grading will make our RV parking on a slight uphill slant as the road will be lower than the current grade. This is just a preliminary plan, as we get closer to the turnover date, more information will be shared. The City Inspector offered to come to our next meeting if we wanted him to and answer any questions you might have about this change.

I spoke with Scott Hood from Specialty Builders on November 4th, who the board originally awarded the repair contract for the wall along Curlew Road. As you know, things have changed since we received the original quote. The board will need to revisit the quote and possibly look at replacing the entire wall. With the construction along Curlew, we are restricted from doing anything, whether it be a repair or a total replacement. As I said at the October meeting, the delay will allow more time to raise money to pay for the wall. Specialty Builders said they will provide the board with a new quote so we have an idea of how much it might cost. Once we receive the quote, it will be shared with everyone.

I want to thank the dedicated volunteers who stepped forward to serve on our Compliance Committee. Volunteering your time to uphold our standards is appreciated.

On behalf of the BOD, I want to wish each of you and your families a very Merry Christmas and a joyful, healthy New Year!

"In May of 2024 we purchased a new membrane roof from Comfort Cover Systems Clearwater. This summer, 2025, we noticed it was becoming brown, like dirt was sticking to it. Upon further investigation we discovered that is exactly what is happening. The CEO of CCS told us that the membrane manufacturer, IB Roofing (IBR), had applied a chemical agent that was supposed to make the surface slicker, but instead had the opposite effect causing dirt that otherwise would have washed off with the rain to hold fast and accumulate. The CSS CEO also told us that they had installed this product on HUNDREDS of dwellings in the area. It is extremely troubling to know they have been using this product since 2021. CCS suggested we contact IBR, which we did. IBR declared the issue a "maintenance problem" not covered by the no-leak warranty and suggested we hire a contractor (that they and CCS had set up!) to clean our roof every six months for three years and then once a year indefinitely, all at our expense. Both CSS and IBR have stopped responding to us and we are considering legal action. That said we do not want any of our friends and neighbors at GAV to experience the same fate we did." D&JV

ARCHITECTURE GUIDELINES

As GULL AIRE continues to get new residents, I thought I would stress how important it is to put in an application for improvements to your new residence. Even though you might think it is very minor, we do have guidelines that must be followed. St. Pete Tarpon Canal Crossing Update

The City of St. Petersburg's contractor is nearly finished with the project to replace the aerial portion of the pipe across the Tarpon Outfall Canal. The blue pipe that spans the canal outlived its useful life and is being replaced by an underground segment of pipe.

Archer Western, the City's contractor, has completed the tie-in from the existing in-ground 48-inch steel reinforced concrete pipe to the new 54-inch HDPE pipe without disruption. The new pipe is now helping carry up to 20 million gallons of water per day to St. Petersburg.

As of the first week in November, the sections of the original in-ground pipe between the tie-in location and the aerial pipe on both sides of the canal have been filled with grout. Crews cut down the steel sheet pilings to ground level and have backfilled the drill pits. They are working to remove the crane mats and road mats and grade the easement.

They will also be removing excess mulch from the easement where the Brazilian pepper trees were removed. Without the invasive species, Gull Aire Village will have a much easier time maintaining the easement.

After the security fence is removed, crews will sod the easement in the work zone and restore the RV lot. At the City of Oldsmar's request, Archer Wester is connecting Montego Court and Salmon Court for easier access to the City's lift station and for an additional evacuation exit for Gull Aire Village in case of emergencies. Crews will install a new, larger locked gate between the two streets, and City of Oldsmar personnel will hold the key.

The sidewalk from Canal Way to the Oldsmar Trail has been completed so residents can enjoy a safe stroll to the trail, and a new, wider gate will keep the access point safe.

The City of St. Petersburg, Archer Western and the entire project team thank you for your consideration and patience during construction. We appreciate you letting us use the RV lot for the laydown yard. We know this project has been disruptive, and we sincerely appreciate your understanding through it all.
